Vote by Absentee Ballot in NJ in 2025.
Executive Summary

In 2025, New Jersey (NJ) will elect a new Governor and Lieutenant Governor, running together on a ticket like the President and Vice President of the United States. NJ voters will also elect members of the lower house of the state legislature this year. If you are on active duty in one of our nation's eight uniformed services, and if you are absent from your NJ home because of your service, you are eligible to vote by absentee ballot in the 2025 primary and general election in NJ. Law Review 25019 contains all the information that you will need to vote by absentee ballot in NJ this year.

Eligibility to vote by absentee ballot also applies to civilian spouses and voting-age children of NJ service members who are absent from their NJ homes because they are accompanying a service member.
